# THE LAMPORT RECTORY

**THIS IS A GRADE II\* LISTED BUILDING**

**THIS WAS THE FORMER RECTORY BUILT IN 1726 NEXT TO THE CHURCH IN LAMPORT FORMING AN UNUSUAL TRILOGY OF NEIGHBOURING BUILDINGS WITH CHURCH & HALL.**

**THE PROPERTY CONSISTS OF TWO PADDOCKS WITH AN ATTRACTIVE GARDEN THAT LOOKS OUT OVER THE VALLEY OF THE RIVER NENE.**

**IT IS A THREE-STOREY MANSION IN GEORGIAN STYLE IN LOCAL STONE DESIGNED BY FRANCIS SMITH OF WARWICK FOR THE REVEREND EUSEBY ISHAM, VICAR OF LAMPORT CHURCH.**

**IT CONTAINS NINE BEDROOMS, FOUR BATHROOMS, TWO RECEPTION ROOMS, DINING ROOM, STUDY, LARGE HALL WITH A GRAND SWEEPING STAIRCASE.**
