**1086 – Henry de Isham recorded in Domesday Book**

c.1500 - The family were found at Isham and Pytchley.

1560 – John Isham purchased Lamport Manor.

1608 – John Isham was created a Knight.

## THE BARONETCY

1611 - The English Baronetage was instituted by King James I.

**30<sup>th</sup> May 1627 - Sir John Isham was created a Baronet.**

From 1651 - Sir Justinian Isham - 2<sup>nd</sup> Baronet.

From 1674 - Sir Thomas Isham - 3<sup>rd</sup> Baronet.

From 1681 - Sir Justinian Isham - 4<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

**In 1727 – 100 years.**

From 1730 - Sir Justinian Isham - 5<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 1736 - Sir Edmund Isham - 6<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 1772 - Sir Justinian Isham - 7<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 1818 - Sir Justinian Isham - 8<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

**In 1827 – 200 years.**

From 1845 - Sir Justinian Vere Isham - 9<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 1846 - Sir Charles Isham - 10<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 1903 - Sir Vere Isham - 11<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

**In 1927 – 300 years.**

From 1944 - Sir Gyles Isham - 12<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 1976 - Sir Ian Isham - 13<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

From 2009 - Sir Norman Isham - 14<sup>th</sup> Baronet.

**In 2027 – 400 years.**

**In 2127 – 500 years!?**

In the 400<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Edition of the Standing Council of the Baronetage Official Roll of Baronets in date order of Patent **Isham of Lamport** is listed at number 61.

Since 1976 the Baronets banner has not been raised above the pediment of **Lamport Hall** as it can no longer be the Residence of the Baronet.
