JOINED THE RAF VOLUNTEER RESERVE SERVED IN 272 SQUADRON - MOTTO "On, On!" **RECENTLY CONVERTED TO BRISTOL BEAUFIGHTERS** WITH TWIN BRISTOL HERCULES OR R-R MERLIN ENGINES WITH A CREW OF TWO – PILOT AND OBSERVER. THE GREAT BRITISH INNOVATION OF THE EARLY WAR YEARS BEING THE ONLY RAF LONG-RANGE FIGHTER AIRCRAFT IN THE MEDITERRANEAN SECTOR. POSTED WITH THE SQUADRON TO LUQA, MALTA IN 1942 WHERE THE DUTIES INCLUDED CONVOY PROTECTION, DEFENCE OF MALTA. INTRUDER MISSIONS AGAINST AXIS SUPPLIES TO ROMMEL'S FORCES IN THE DESERT. WHICH CONTRIBUTED TO THE SUCCESS OF THE EL ALEMAIN OFFENSIVE, AND INCURSIONS INTO SICILY AND TUNISIA, ALL UNDER THE COMMAND OF AIR VICE-MARSHALL KEITH PARK. WHERE PROBABLY ON CONVOY ESCORT DUTY **ARTHUR WAS KILLED IN ACTION ON 22 MAY 1943** AGED 20 YEARS.
