WOUNDED IN BATTLE OF TRANSLOY

“On 11th October 1916 his 7th Battalion set out across open ground at 2 pm coming under very heavy automatic rifle & machine-gun fire. Captain Isham was badly wounded that pm and spent the night in a shell hole with Lt. Bowen, who was also wounded, while the dreadful Battle of Transloy raged around them”.
