He flew Short's Empire flying-boats to Africa from Southampton in the 1930's; then in 1943 he was one of four Captains that were responsible for the flights for Winston Churchill to attend the first of several meetings of the "Big Three", then being Winston Churchill, Franklin D. Roosevelt and Joseph Stalin, at the famous Tehran Conference, held in the Soviet Embassy, deciding to commit the Western Allies to the opening of the second front against Nazi Germany. After the war, in retirement, he gave his time to activities in The National Trust, where his efforts that were largely undertaken in the Egyptian House in Penzance justly earned him the National Trust Highest Award for Excellence in 1988.
