* Sir John, the first of the Isham baronets of "Lamport Hall," and Henry Isham of "Bermuda Hundred" were second cousins once removed. ** Celebrated Isham descendants via the Randolph & Eppes families of Virginia include:

- Pevton Randolph, first President of the Continental Congress;
- Thomas Jefferson, founder of the University of Virginia, first Secretary of State, and third President of the United States, and his wife <u>Martha Wayles Skelton</u> (as well as both of their daughters and sons-in-law);
- Edmund Randolph, Washington's aide-de-camp and first Attorney General of the United States;
- John Marshall, the great Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court;
- Henry ("Light Horse Harry") Lee, Revolutionary War hero & Washington favorite; his son, Confederate General <u>Robert E.</u> Lee & his wife <u>Mary Anne Randolph Custis</u>, great-granddaughter of Martha Washington;
- Confederate General J.E.B. Stuart;
- Edith Bolling Galt, the second Mrs. Woodrow Wilson ("first woman President" and great-granddaughter seven times removed of Pocahontas); and
- the Langhornes of Virginia: Nancy, <u>Lady Astor, M.P.</u>; her sister Irene, <u>Mrs. Charles Dana Gibson</u> (the first Gibson Girl); and their nieces, <u>Nancy Lancaster</u> (interior designer and creator of the English Country House look, and one-time granddaughter-in-law of Marshall Field), and Joyce (Phipps) Grenfell, the English actress and comedienne.

Isham descendants also include:

- numerous Governors and First Ladies of Virginia,
- several Presidents of the College of William and Mary,
- the wife of another U.S. Supreme Court Justice,
- a first lady of New York City, two mayors of Chicago, and one mayor of Tallahassee, Florida,
- the wife of the founder of IBM and the long-time owners of Macy's Department Store, and
- most of Tidewater Virginia's historic James River Plantation families.
