The Isham Baronets of Lamport

Selected Facts

- *Baronetcy's Age*: 387 yrs in 2014, 61st baronetcy created in England, 46th surviving one, 24th as senior title in use
- *Bart (vs Bt)*: recognizes antiquity of title
- *Current Baronet*: Sir Norman, suc 2009
- *Lady Isham*: Joan (Genet), 1st since 1961
- *1st Baronetcy*: Sir John, Cr 1627
- *Longest Baronetcies*: Sir Charles (57 yrs), Sir Justinian II (49), Sir Justinian IV (46)
- *Shortest Baronetcies*: Sir Justinian VI (1 yr), Sir Thomas (3), Sir Justinian III (7)

Of 13 successions since 1651:

- 6 father-son (fewer than half)
- 7 other than father-son, including:
 - 4 brother-brother (2nd most likely type, 1/3 of total, > 1/2 of non-father-son)
 - 2 cousin-cousin, 1 uncle-nephew

- *Since 1772*: all successions beyond immediate family have been to the lines of **clergymen**
- *Successions since 1818 (almost 200 years)*:
2 father-son, 2 brother-brother, 2 cousin-cousin
