US

THE ORIGINAL US SILVER DOLLAR - OVER 90 YEARS OLD.

"THE COLT .45, THE SHERIFF'S STAR & THE GLEAMING SILVER DOLLAR"

These were the ingredients of a gun-slinging life in the mining and cattle towns of the Wild West.

The LAST EVER US MORGAN DOLLAR – 1921. The "TRUE" SILVER COIN of the WILD WEST.

These "Morgan" Dollars (named after the designer) were struck from 26g of precious 90% pure silver – and that was their downfall. Millions upon millions were melted down by the US Government and speculators for silver bullion, thereby making this "Morgan" Dollar ever more scarce and, as a consequence, ever more desireable. Each is 38.1 mm in diameter and 20.7 g in weight of 900/1000 silver, minted in Philadelphia, USA between 1878-1904 and, as this, in 1921. The obverse depicts a profile portrait representing "LIBERTY".

UK

THE VERY LAST QUEEN VICTORIA STERLING SILVER CROWN

The silver crown coin is a very old British tradition, in fact more than 450 years old and this is sought-after as it has had "IND IMP" added. This is an original 120 year old coin at 38.61 mm diameter of 1 ounce dated 1893 in sterling silver, which is 92.5% pure. It is the "Widow" crown being the only coin with a veil & being in circulation until 1901. The edge "ANNO REGNI LV1 AMEN" indicates the 1st regnal year.

This silver Crown coin forms an everlasting commemoration of the reign of Queen Victoria that lasted for 63 years - from 1837 to 1901.

These two national coins have such a remarkable similarity in appearance - being both struck in pure silver, both at 38 mm diameter, both with a female figure in profile, both with a notable national emblem, both being minted in around 1900.
