**JOAN'S FATHER** 

**LEONARD JAMES GENET** b.1898

AGED 16 VOLUNTEERED IN 1914

BY ENROLLING IN THE LONDON SCOTTISH REGIMENT SERVED IN THE SOMME OFFENSIVE IN 1916 WHERE HE WAS BADLY WOUNDED AGED 18.

IN 1922 JOINED AT AGE 24

THE BRITISH SOUTH AFRICA POLICE IN SOUTHERN RHODESIA IN 1964 AWARDED THE BRITISH EMPIRE MEDAL FOR POLICE SERVICES IN 1965 RETIRED AT THE RANK OF CHIEF INSPECTOR AGED 67.

APPOINTED SECRETARY TO THE UMTALI CLUB.

IN 1968 DIED IN RETIREMENT AT AGE 69 NORMAN'S FATHER

#### **VERE ARTHUR RICHARD ISHAM** b.1889

AGED 24 JOINED-UP IN 1913

BY ENROLLING IN THE 7TH. SUFFOLK REGIMENT AGED 25 SERVED IN THE BRITISH EXPEDITIONARY FORCE IN 1914 THEN IN AUG.1916 SERVED IN THE SOMME OFFENSIVE AT AGE 26 AT THE RANK OF CAPTAIN

AWARDED THE MILITARY CROSS IN THE BATTLE OF POZIERES RIDGE THEN IN THE BATTLE OF LE TRANSLOY IN OCT.1916 HE WAS BADLY WOUNDED IN THE CHEST AGED 27 WHEN HE WAS MENTIONED IN DESPATCHES TWICE.

VOLUNTEERED IN THE NORTH RUSSIA EXPEDITIONARY FORCE IN 1918. IN 1939 CEASES TO BE ON THE RESERVE OF OFFICERS

IN 1940 JOINS MI 9 DURING WWII.

AT AGE 56 RETIRED AT THE RANK OF LIEUT. COLONEL IN 1945 IN 1968 DIED IN RETIREMENT AT AGE 79.

**NORMAN'S UNCLE** 

VERE'S YOUNGER BROTHER

**HENRY EUSEBY MURRAY ISHAM** b.1895

AGED 19 ENROLLED IN THE SUFFOLK REGIMENT IN 1914 IN 1916 SERVED IN THE SOMME OFFENSIVE AT AGE 21 WAS GASSED IN THE TRENCHES AND IN 1930 DIED IN SOUTH AFRICA AT AGE 35.
